Dear Judge Dunnigan:

We are residents of Trailer Estates and are writing you in hopes there is some way our treasury can be protected from the lawsuit fees being drawn from it by the defendants in this suit. This lawsuit is currently costing our treasury much more than we can be expected to repay in many years. There is talk recently about the trustees seeking a loan from which the fees can continue to be paid. How can a small community such as ours continue and not go bankrupt? Do we as a community have any recourse to this apparent unlimited growth of our indebtedness? How can the defendants be motivated to settle if they have unlimited funds upon which to draw?

The way our government at T.E. works is that the trustees between elections have assumed sole responsibility for conducting our business and nothing is put to a vote by the members of the community. Thus there is no apparent way we can control these expenditures between elections. Since only a portion (4) of the nine member board is up this fall we will have to wait another year to curb this behavior unless some consensus can be arrived at by the community before then. In the mean time the debt grows.
