**ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO COMPEL FORENSIC EXAMINATION
OF DEFENDANT MARTIN'S PERSONAL COMPUTERS**

THIS MATTER came before the Court on November 19, 2008, upon plaintiffs' Motion to Compel Forensic Examination of defendant Martin's personal computers. After hearing the arguments of counsel, reviewing the Court file, and otherwise being advised in the premises, it is:

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that:

1. Plaintiffs' motion is granted.
2. John Jorgensen shall conduct a forensic examination of defendant Martin's harddrives to recover deleted public records from defendant Martin's personal computers only. All previous orders with respect to NOT conducting an examination of the harddrive of the other parties shall remain in effect. Counsel shall communicate this Order to Mr. Jorgensen telephonically, and Mr. Jorgensen shall have fourteen (14) days to conduct the examination. Defendant Martin shall pay the cost of the exam.
