6. Five residents suggest having a Park Manager (who works) to reduce Mark's staff.
  - a. A park manager's salary would be in the range of \$100,000.00 a year. This would increase our assessment and the park would still have to have nine trustees. Several years ago Trailer Estates did have a park manager.
7. Eight residents wanted more seminars such as finances, taxes, health.
  - a. The program committee has been having seminars on these subjects advertising on channel 18 and on bulletin boards. The seminar on Tuesday, Jan. 24th by David Shulmister and only 15 residents attended.

Last year on Feb. 15th we had a seminar on funeral wishes, stages of care, living wills, etc. with very low attendance.

Perhaps our residents should visit the Senior Center on 26th Street for seminars they are interested in attending.

Feel unless we have attendance of at least 50 residents it is not worth the time of the committee or the speaker to schedule these meetings.

8. Six residents want to see the details of monthly spending.
  - a. As of Monday, Jan. 23, 2006 copies of Trailer Estates financial statement are posted on bulletin boards in T.E. office; on board outside of Small Hall; and on board at Post Office.
9. Five residents said that Trustees should not say "if you don't like it here, go someplace else."

Have heard comments from individuals that other parks do not have a quarter of the instruction, classes or entertainment that our park offers.
