Wayne Hamblen said the floor should be started by Wednesday and should be finished by the weekend.

Janet Jones watched the Commissioners meeting on T.V. There will be seventy- (70) people displaced from Bowless Creek and traffic will be tremendous for our park.

Peg Durham said from now on there needs to be a date on the cards put on the bulletin boards and anything over a 3x5 card will be taken down.

Margo Cushman said everything is running smooth in her area.

Jerry Sullivan said the first Showtime would be November 17<sup>th</sup> and the dances will start on November 5,

Mary Lou McNulty said Bob Moore would be the moderator for Candidates Night on November 3<sup>rd</sup> at 7:00 p.m. in the large hall.

Mary Lou McNulty asked who the Citizens Action Committee was and nobody came forward. She also wanted to know who the people are. No one on the Board knows anything about the committee.

Mary Lou McNulty elaborated on the Trailer Estates Website. This has nothing to do with Trailer Estates just private individuals.
