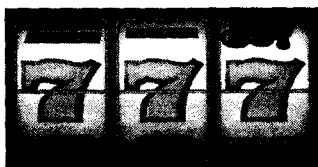

C.E.R.T.

Community Emergency Response Team

Time to have your "go to the shelter" bag ready. Make sure your medications are ready to go as well as any important papers. Informational pamphlets are available in the Activity Building should you need more guidelines. Make sure you have bottled water on hand in case of an emergency. Please go to a shelter when an emergency is declared. In a hurricane, high water is as much of an enemy as the wind. We could be 20 feet under water in a surge. Please never try to ride it out.

We have recently heard that some residents believe that C.E.R.T. is the Disaster Plan for the residents of the Park. That information is NOT correct. C.E.R.T. is an emergency response team. C.E.R.T. only is involved in search and rescue when activated by Manatee County. We will assist the Fire Dept in other functions when requested. We do not assist in reentry into the park or in any sort of clean up operations. We are not able to assist with food or shelter and do not have the capabilities to assist with FEMA or any other sources of financial aide. The park does not currently have a plan for the residents.

C.E.R.T. is ready to assist if the need arises. We are one of the few organizations that trains and hopes that their training time is wasted.

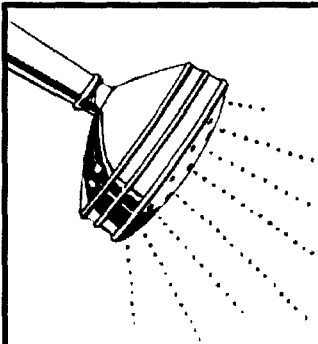

If you can't see anything outside or unless you know who the person is, DO NOT open your door to anyone, or for any strange noises.

If you suspect they are up to no good or you hear something suspicious, call 911 immediately and relay any information to the emergency operator about the subject(s), if seen, or what you heard. If you hear suspicious noises at night, call 911 immediately; DO NOT go outside! If someone claims there is an emergency, call 911 and find out if there really is one. Whatever you do, be aware that criminals will sometimes use your good Samaritan attitude to trick you into a bad situation. Take the time to be safe and make sure it is okay to open your door to someone you don't know.
