As we discussed, it is the position of the Division that the food service activities of Trailer Lakes Estates Kitchen requires a State of Florida food service license. This was conveyed to the establishment in the form of an inspection and legal notice. At a subsequent re-inspection an additional 60 days was allotted to come into compliance. The date for that second re-inspection is on or about June 8th, 2010. You may wish to retain competent legal counsel on how best to proceed in this matter should you decide not to acquire a license.
