BEFORE THE COURT is Trailer Estates Park and Recreation District's ("District")  
Second Motion for Partial Summary Judgment. The District and Plaintiffs having conferred and  
agreed upon the following, the Court ORDERS:

1. 37(II)- Discussion Regarding Handling Deed Restriction Violations.

The District's motion for summary judgment is withdrawn as to allegation 37(II).

2. 37(v)- Discussion Regarding Policies PP3, PP5, PP41, and PP 53.

The Court GRANTS summary judgment on a basis of cure consistent with the Court's  
Order on Janet Jones' Second Motion for Partial Summary Judgment dated June 2, 2010.



3. 37(z)- Memorandum Regarding ARC Permits.

The Court GRANTS summary judgment finding this allegation relates to administrative matters consistent with the Court's Order on Janet Jones' Second Motion for Partial Summary Judgment dated June 2, 2010.

4. 37(sss)- Discussions Regarding Diaster Plan.

The Court GRANTS summary judgment on a basis of cure consistent with the Court's Order on Janet Jones' Second Motion for Partial Summary Judgment dated June 2, 2010.

5. 37(nnnn)- Determination that free internet service should not be provided.


The District's motion for summary judgment is withdrawn as to allegation 37(nnnn).

6. Addenda 44(iv)- Liaison Conveyed Information Regarding Public Records Policy

The Court GRANTS summary judgment on a basis of cure consistent with the Court's Order on Janet Jones' Motion for Partial Summary Judgment dated February 8, 2010.
