- A new drain will be placed in the spa next month and the floor in the ladies room at the pool will be fixed.
- Debbie will attend a Manatee County disaster plan meeting and will bring information back to the Board.
- Please break down your cardboard boxes before recycling them.
- Volunteers, turn your March hours in to Margo.
- The fate of the boat hoist will be voted on at the next Board meeting.
- The Board voted to dispose of a Dell CPU minus hard drive. Bids will be accepted until noon Friday, May 13, and will be opened at the May 16 Board meeting. Residents can look at it Tuesday-Thursday between 1-3 p.m.
- The Fire Marshall has mandated a voice evacuation system for the Large and Small halls to be installed this summer.
- The Board decided to offer renter residents the same privileges and costs of marina spaces, storage lot spaces and facility usage as those afforded property owners in Trailer Estates.
- The floor in the Large Hall will be refinished in September. The hall will be closed for about a week to complete the project.
- Rumor control: The statement that “someone in the office leaked a confidential document (the lawsuit settlement agreement proposal of March 2009) to the residents as a sabotage” is not true. The document was faxed to the park by Kirk Pinkerton, attorneys for Trailer Estates.
